QUESTIONS

ASKED

- All teachers will wear masks at all times
- We will have stable groups of children and teachers. Groups will not exceed 10 children, will not mix with other groups or other teachers. Floating staff will be used to provide breaks for the teachers, but breaks will be done outside the classroom so social distancing can be maintained and floaters won't have close contact with the children. If a break has to be given inside, we will try to plan it for nap time so no close interaction is required between the children and floating teacher.
- We are increasing the amount of time outside since we have such a large campus and can set up outside play zones
- Outdoor play areas and equipment (including the play structures and swings) will be disinfected with a static sprayer after each group. The sandbox will be closed.
- Kids will have their own consumable supplies (crayons, glue, scissors, etc.), all classrooms toys will be disinfected between children. Soft/fuzzy items will be packed up for now.
- Surfaces of the classroom will be disinfected hourly.
- Hand washing will be done hourly and in between as needed.
- Campus will be closed to parents and visitors. Drop off and pickup will be done outside at designated zones and times. There will be daily questions to determine whether or not a child can attend (anyone in the home with symptoms, any travel for business or pleasure, any known contact with a positive or presumed positive person)
- Temps will be taken at drop off (for the parent as well). Anything over 99.9 will restrict attendance for 72 hours, at minimum.
- Staff and child temps will be taken throughout the day.
- No personal items can be brought on campus-only a reusable water bottle and lunch bag daily and nap items each Monday.
- We will have Friday folders that go home with the kids so there isn't an exchange of papers between teachers and parents each day.
- We will not do close contact classroom activities like circle time. Kids will be encouraged to give others "personal space" and we will avoid sitting children face to face whenever possible.
- Masks are encouraged by the county but NOT required-we will enforce as best we can for families who want their child to wear a mask.
